Some of what follows is provable, Westergren says; some is family lore. The first relative to set foot on Texas soil was Owen Gaffney. He was wounded early in the Civil War which made him available to be on both the Grand Jury and Jury that convicted Chipita Rodriguez. By all accounts the Jury wanted mercy but the Judge wanted a quick hanging which he got. Congressman John Young was also a member of the family. In fact each generation including that of our speaker has held numerous public offices.

Judge Mike Westergren has served as Justice of the Peace, County Attorney, District Judge, and as Vice President of Nueces County Historical Society.

The Nueces County Historical Society meets the first Tuesday of the months of September through April each year with a wide-range of programs and presentations focused on the rich local history of Nueces County and the surrounding area. 


