In 1946, he joined the U. S. Army. He was stationed in Korea during that conflict. He retired from the Army after serving 21 years. He participated in the 1964 Olympic Games in Tokyo. He is currently an educator, sports official, a writer with a weekly history column in the "Island Moon" newspaper, conducts the Thursday morning Veterans Round Table and the Veterans Radio Round Table on Saturday morning radio.
